



Classes

In the Classes area you can move your students between classes, as well as divide your class into a number of learning groups, allowing you to assign different levels of work to specific groups of students.

- 1 Select the class you wish to work with from the dropdown menu at the top of the screen.
- 2 Click **+ New Group**, and give your new group a name and default course.
Note: this name is not visible to students.
- 3 You can now move students into this new group. Click **Move Students** and simply drag and drop from the main list of student names over to the newly created tab for the group.
- 4 Should you need to, you can **rename** or **delete** your group at any time using the button at the bottom of the screen.



Groups are fantastic for mixed ability classes, allowing individual learning pathways for specific students.



Students in groups remain in their original class for results purposes but will have access to the different word lists assigned to their group.



You can split a class into up to 6 groups, each with their own individual settings.
