An important announcement from Mathletics

Dear Parents,

Your child's school math program includes access to the online learning resource Mathletics. We will soon begin our annual archiving of data, and wanted you to be aware of how that works and what it means.

At the beginning of each school year, student accounts within Mathletics are refreshed by filing away results data from the previous academic year. This important process ensures that Mathletics will run at maximum effectiveness when your child accesses new curriculum content in the next grade.

In preparation for the 2016-17 school year, data archiving will take place on [Sunday-Monday, September 4-5.](#)

What this means for your child:

The archiving process does not delete data, but stores it to create room for new curriculum results in the upcoming academic year. Once archived, activity results and gold bars earned in the prior school year will not be visible to students. **But please note:** Archiving only impacts curriculum results data. You can reassure your child that all avatar customizations, lifetime points, certificates earned, and Live Mathletics scores are unaffected and will remain visible and accessible.
